A. W. Crain Diamond Award

The A. W. Crain Diamond Award can be awarded to any member or friend of the Texas Turfgrass Association whose meritorious service deserves the highest award of the Association. A recipient shall have:

1. Maintained active years of service in the turf industry.
2. Participated in programs leading to the improvement of the turfgrass industry.
3. Initiated special programs on behalf of the turfgrass industry.
4. Expressed willingness and ability to handle turfgrass-related tasks over and above normal activities.
5. Participated actively in the affairs of the Texas Turfgrass Association.
6. Maintained the highest standards in personal conduct and appearance.
7. Established a history of community and civic responsibilities.
8. Donated or contributed to projects affecting the turfgrass industry.
9. Contributed measurably to the development of forward momentum of the Texas Turfgrass Association.

SPECIAL AWARDS

A special award may be conferred upon any person who has made an outstanding contribution to the field of turf management. The recipient of a Special Award shall be a distinguished member of long, faithful and honorable service in the turfgrass management field. The recipient shall have developed and maintained to a high degree the areas with which they have been associated, shall have advanced the turfgrass management conception in their own locale, and shall have actively participated in the furtherance and welfare of the turfgrass management movement through other means.
